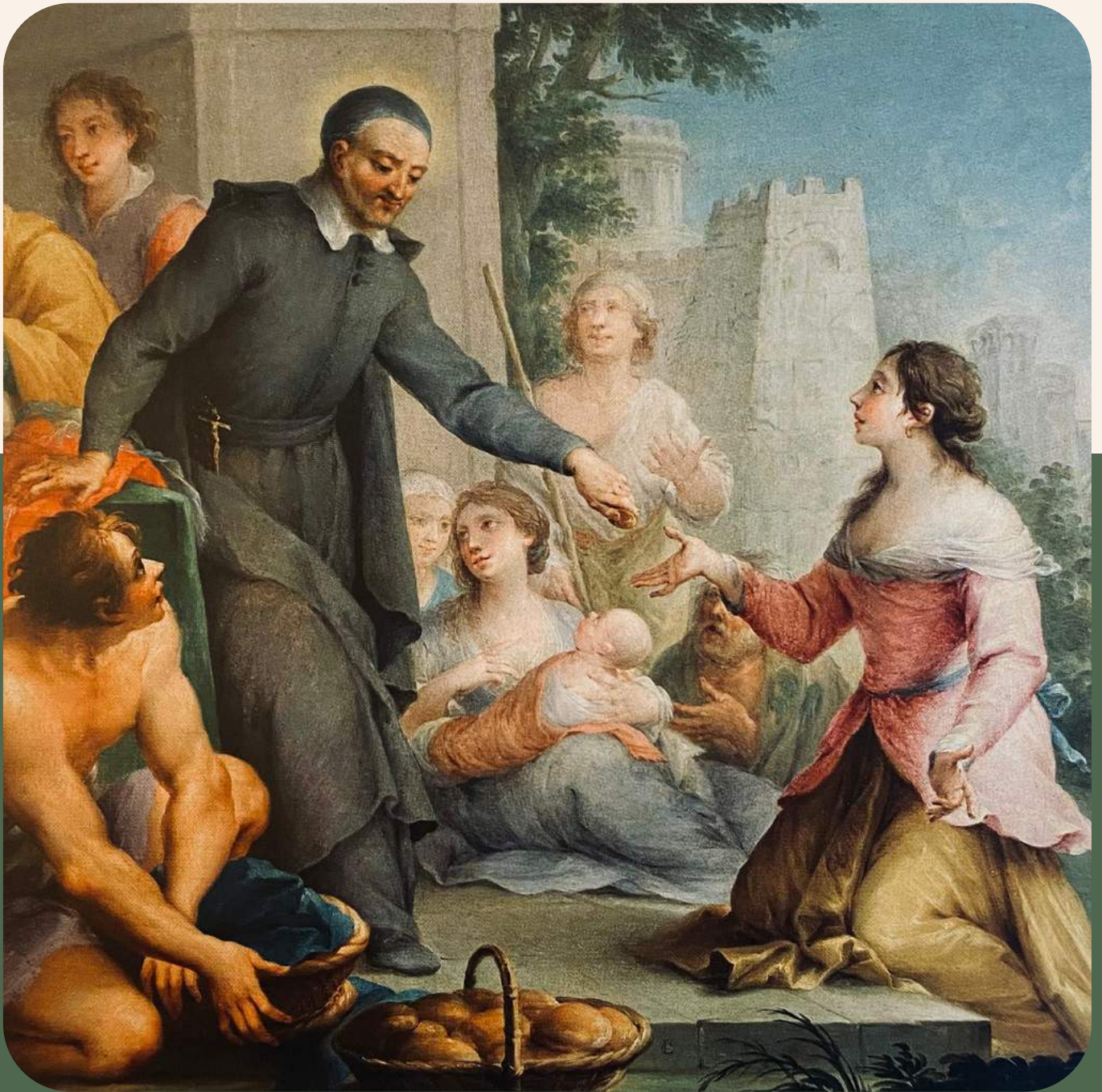

Ordinations to the priesthood in the Brazilian Province of the Congregation of the Mission 2022



The PBCM has many reasons to be happy, among them, some Priestly Ordinations. Two of its deacons will now be able to serve in the Mission as Priests, they are: Deacon Cleber Teodósio, CM and Deacon Miguel Araújo, CM.

The first, received the second degree of the Order by the prayer of the Church, prayer of ordination and imposition of hands of Monsignor José Luiz Gomes de Vasconcelos, Bishop of the Diocese of Sobral, in the Church Matriz Nossa Senhora da Conceição de Bela Cruz - Ceará, at 18:00 hours, on 26 November 2022.

P. Cleber, whose motto is: "Lift up the lowly" (Lk 1, 52), presided at the first Mass in the same Church, at 7 am, on the day when the Vincentian Family and the whole Church solemnly celebrate Our Lady of the Miraculous Medal (27 November). He will continue to serve in the Parish Padre Misericordioso in Belo Horizonte - Minas Gerais, where he developed his diaconate.

Michel, in turn, was ordained priest by the consecratory prayer and imposition of hands by Monsignor José Carlos Chacorowski, CM, bishop of the Diocese of Caraguatatuba, in the Matriz Sant'Ana Church, in Bambuí - Minas Gerais, a city marked by the holy presence of the Lazarists, at 7 p.m., on December 3, 2022.

The motto that our confrere chose to guide his ministry was taken from Philippians 2:5: "Have the same mind as Christ Jesus". The new priest presided at Holy Mass for the first time at the Sanctuary of São Sebastião, also in Bambuí, at 9.30 a.m. on 4 December 2022, with the joy of celebrating his parents' 35 years of marriage. He will continue to serve in the Parish Nossa Senhora da Medalha Milagrosa in Riacho Fundo II - DF, where he served as a deacon.

Present at both ordinations were the Provincial Visitor, Fr. Eli Chaves, CM, different priests, deacons and students of the Province, clergy and seminarians of the host dioceses, Daughters of Charity, Vincentian Marian Youth, Society of St. Vincent de Paul and other branches of the Vincentian Family, as well as some members of other religious congregations, pastoral and movements; relatives, friends and other children of the Church of the respective localities, who fraternised with the new priests, celebrating vocational triduum in the days prior to the ordinations, meeting new people, making new friends, and discovering the natural beauty, culture and gastronomy of the regions where the two events took place.

These celebrations are signs of God's love for the Church and our Congregation and the fruit of many hands committed with love and gratuity. Thank you all. May Jesus, Mary and St. Vincent obtain precious blessings from God for each and everyone.

Dear International Vincentian Family, Our affectionate and fraternal hug!

We hope this letter finds you well and full of joy as World Youth Days (WYD) and our International Vincentian Youth Meeting (IVYM) are approaching!

We wanted to remind you that registration is now open and that we have some updates to communicate to you. Don't forget that the 1st phase of registration ends on December 20th! We have no time to waste, as this 10% discount on WYD will certainly be very good for all. However, we also remind you of the dates of the next two phases:

2nd phase: from 21/12/2022 to 05/03/2023, with a 5% discount on the WYD package

3rd stage: from 03/06/2023 to 06/15/2023, no discount.

Regarding the way in which registrations and data from young people should be collected, there are two steps to be followed and which we will explain to you.

1st step: After a group collects applications from its members, the National Council President for the branch in question, or deputy vice president, should complete the following form: <https://forms.gle/M8deBLBU1hrw9M8J9>. In this form, more simplified data will be requested only about the person in charge and about the group itself.

2nd step: After answering the form, an excel document must be completed, which is at the end of the form. The excel document must be filled in with the personal data of each pilgrim in the group.

ATTENTION! In the excel document, do not forget to fill in the header that identifies the group.

3rd step: To make the payment, you must do it for the following IBAN:

6th World Day of the Poor



The World Day of the Poor event took place on November 13, 2022, in the facilities of the Vincentian Faculty (FAVI) 531 Jaime Reis Street - Curitiba / PR, this day that Pope Francis established in the Church to pray and carry out concrete actions for this population that suffers so much in the streets of big cities.

The event was organised by the Pastoral de las Personas en Situación de Calle and with the support of several other institutions including: Congregation of the Mission, which gave the space of the Vincentian Faculty for the event, Sisters Daughters of Charity, Toca de Assis, Sisters Servants of Mary Mother of the Church, Sisters of Chamberi, and SSVP Representatives, other volunteers from various parishes in Curitiba who helped in the realization of the event. In total, an average of 70 volunteers contributed to the execution of the event.

The activities carried out were: bathing in the shelter house San José (space of the Daughters of Charity) and, in the space of the Vincentian Faculty there were: Breakfast, activities such as haircut, handicrafts, public defender, psychologists. At 11.15 a mass was celebrated with the homeless and the volunteers who organised the event. After the celebration, a delicious lunch was served and in the afternoon there was a prize-giving ceremony.

At the end of the event, kits were distributed which included: a packet of Bis (donated by volunteers), a sandwich (made by the Seminario Vicenciano Nossa Senhora das Graças), a piece of cake (made by volunteers) and a hygiene kit (donated by the public defender's office). 280 kits were made and an average of 150 were delivered.

With God's grace and Our Lady's intercession, we had a beautiful day of activities and provided a happy and joyful day for these people. May St. Vincent de Paul guide us on this path of evangelisation towards these people who suffer the consequences of society, inequality and the poverty that surrounds us.
